# **Online Registration:**

- Visit the British Council's official exam registration page: <u>British Council IGCSE</u> <u>Registration</u>.
- Complete your registration by providing the required details.



### **Documents for Registration:**

After completing the online registration, please email the following documents to **sch.dxb@ae.britishcouncil.org**. If you're unable to email them, you may visit any British Council office to finalise your registration.

Ensure you email or bring the following:

- Original passport or Emirates ID (valid).
- Copy of your passport or Emirates ID.
- Three recent passport-size photographs (taken within the last 6 months).
- Copy of your online registration summary.
- Signed copy of the candidate declaration form.

### • Important Notes for Private Candidates:

- As per Ministry of Education and Youth (MoEY) regulations, private candidates' certificates will not be endorsed by the MoEY and will not allow for continuation of studies in the UAE.
- All registered subjects must be taken at the same venue designated by the British Council (Abu Dhabi or Dubai).
- You can only register with one centre/exam board for any given session. If you
  register with multiple centres, the British Council may disqualify you.

#### • Exam Timelines:

- IGCSE candidates should follow a 2-year course, typically taking exams at the end of Year 10 or later.
- A-Level candidates should follow a 2-year course, with AS level exams at the end of Year 11, and A-Level exams at the end of Year 12.

## Statement of Entry:

# • Examination Results:

- The Statement of Results will be available by mid-August 2025, and candidates will be notified via SMS when received.
- Certificates will be available approximately two months after the results, and candidates will be notified by SMS when received.
- If you wish for a parent or guardian to collect your results or certificates on your behalf, please provide them with an authorization letter along with the original Statement of Entry (SOE).
